Year 7 Catch-Up Premium Proposed Spend 2018-19

Item/Project:	Cost:	Objective:
Books for use in Progress Time	£500	Appropriate books for the English Mastery 'Reading for Pleasure' programme. Progress Time will have a Literacy slot that is used specifically for the teaching of Tier Two vocabulary. Knowledge quizzes that used every four sessions will track their progress here.
Lexia and staff member to run this programme.	£22,000	To support identified vulnerable pupils to develop decoding skills. Students who did not score on the KS2 Reading tests are the priority for this intervention which will run during the school day and be taught by a qualified teacher with primary training. The impact will be tracked by their acquisition of phonemes and their developing fluency in reading.
Additional Teaching Support – Intervention Leads	£20,000	To increase attainment in Literacy and Numeracy through increased curriculum provision. Small group intervention. Identified students will undertake small group intervention after school. The sessions will be taught by the Faculty Intervention Leads who will be taught and their work monitored. The resources they use are directly linked to the areas of weakness identified by the QLA from the KS2 tests. For Literacy this is inference and for Numeracy this is measurement, shape, proportion and basic numeracy. The impact will be measured by assessment on these specific areas.
Manga High	£750	To increase numeracy skills for vulnerable students. The impact of this has been limited previously but there is the potential for this to be successful if led and tracked accurately.
