Maths	<p>https://sparxmaths.uk/student - log into sparx. Go to independent learning and type in the codes listed on the sheet (inside the Maths folder). All of the codes are separated into the half term topics of the year that you will be completing next year. This is a perfect way to make a head start on your learning for Maths!</p> <p>Access the appropriate tier (foundation or higher) and complete the past GCSE questions.</p>
Science	<p>Read through the getting ready for year 11 science knowledge organiser and then attempt the questions on the activity mat. Check your answers and self-assess.</p>
