





Skill: Put your hand-up in a Teams Lesson

Benefit: This lets the teacher(s) know that you have a question to ask or would like some help.

Instructions:

1. Access the **Teams Lesson**. Focus on the teaching content and complete the learning activities as normal
2. If you come across something which you would like to ask or have explained again, move your cursor so that the **Menu Bar** appears.
3. When the Menu Bar appears, click on the  icon.
4. This then places an orange **Hand Raised** icon next to your name in the **Show Participants** list, and alerts your teacher that you have raised your hand.
5. Your teacher will then, at a convenient point in the Lesson, ask you your question either on the **Chat** or through their microphone.
6. To then Lower Your Hand, click on the icon  again.
