All Y11 students should have received their mock grades in the post. Please note these are not the student's final grades but a reflection of working at grades in March. Final GCSE grades will not be shared until we have a formal results day in the summer, which we will share more information on this when we know more from the government and Ofqual guidance.

We continue to be in contact with colleges. We have provided on our website some guidance from colleges on independent study suggestions, along with a number of Pixl Transition materials that students can be using to better prepare themselves for Post-16 study. Additionally we know colleges are doing their best to contact our students to update them on their college places.
