Food Vouchers to cover the Summer Holiday 2021 We want to ensure that those eligible for free school meals on the grounds of low income receive a food voucher to cover the Summer holiday at £12.50 per week per child for a maximum 6-week period. If your child is entitled to income based free school meals, please look out for an email and/or text confirming that your voucher has been issued. School Uniform

Our school uniform is now in stock, and our approved uniform supplier is Zutti (based on Yorkshire Street in Oldham town centre, open Monday to Saturday). Our uniform consists of the Oasis Academy Oldham blazer, tie, Oasis skirt (or trousers for girls) and PE kit. These are compulsory and **must** be obtained from Zutti. Also required are black trousers, white school shirt and black school shoes (no canvas shoes or trainers allowed). Zutti also sells school trousers and shirts. Girls can choose to wear either the Oasis school skirt or black trousers, however, please note that skinny trousers (on boys or girls) will not be acceptable. If students attend the academy with trousers that do not have a slight flare at the ankle, then they will be sent home to change into the correct uniform.

Please note that when we return in September students will return to the normal uniform wearing and when they have a PE lesson, they will not be required to come to academy in their PE kit. This will be carried in their backpack, and they can change into their PE kit as normal.

Mandatory Equipment List

All students are expected to be fully equipped every day. The equipment listed below is not negotiable. Mandatory equipment:

As part of the mandatory equipment list, every pupil is expected to have a backpack that can fit an A4 folder inside. No other bag will be allowed, and parents will be asked to provide a new bag as per school policy. It is not acceptable for pupils to come to school without a bag. Thank you in advance for your support with this.

When we return in September your child will be supported daily by their Tutor. In addition, each student will have a Head of Year who will be supported by a Pastoral Leader to ensure your child's needs are met. Our Academy Leadership Team will also be linked to specific Year Groups.
