All of the codes are separated into the half term topics of the year that you will be completing next year. This is a perfect way to make a head start on your learning for Maths!</p>
Science	<p>Read through the getting ready for year 10 science knowledge organiser and then attempt the questions on the activity mat. Check your answers and self-assess.</p>

Business	<p>Research your local area/Oldham and get an understanding of the local businesses. Write a report on the kind of businesses that exist. What is their main business idea/purpose? Who do they serve? What are the most popular businesses in your area/Oldham? When you return in September you need to have some knowledge of the local businesses and the variety of business serving a community.</p>
