# About this report

This report shows the findings of the #BeeWell provision survey for physical education and sport. It includes results from your school and results from participating schools across Greater Manchester (GM). The survey can be viewed [here](#).

The survey was open to all #BeeWell schools from October to December 2024. A total of 41 schools, out of 147 #BeeWell schools in GM, responded to the survey.

#BeeWell will use these results to build a better understanding of the relationship between different aspects of provision and young people's wellbeing.



# Using your report

This report provides an overview of Greater Manchester schools' responses to this #BeeWell provision survey. Graphs focus primarily on responses from all participating schools in your area. Where graphs make a comparison between your school and all participating schools across the area, this is described in the title. On these pages, a star will be used to identify your schools' response.

Combined with your own knowledge about your school's provision for physical activity, the report will help you understand how the provision in your school compares to the provision in other schools in your area. 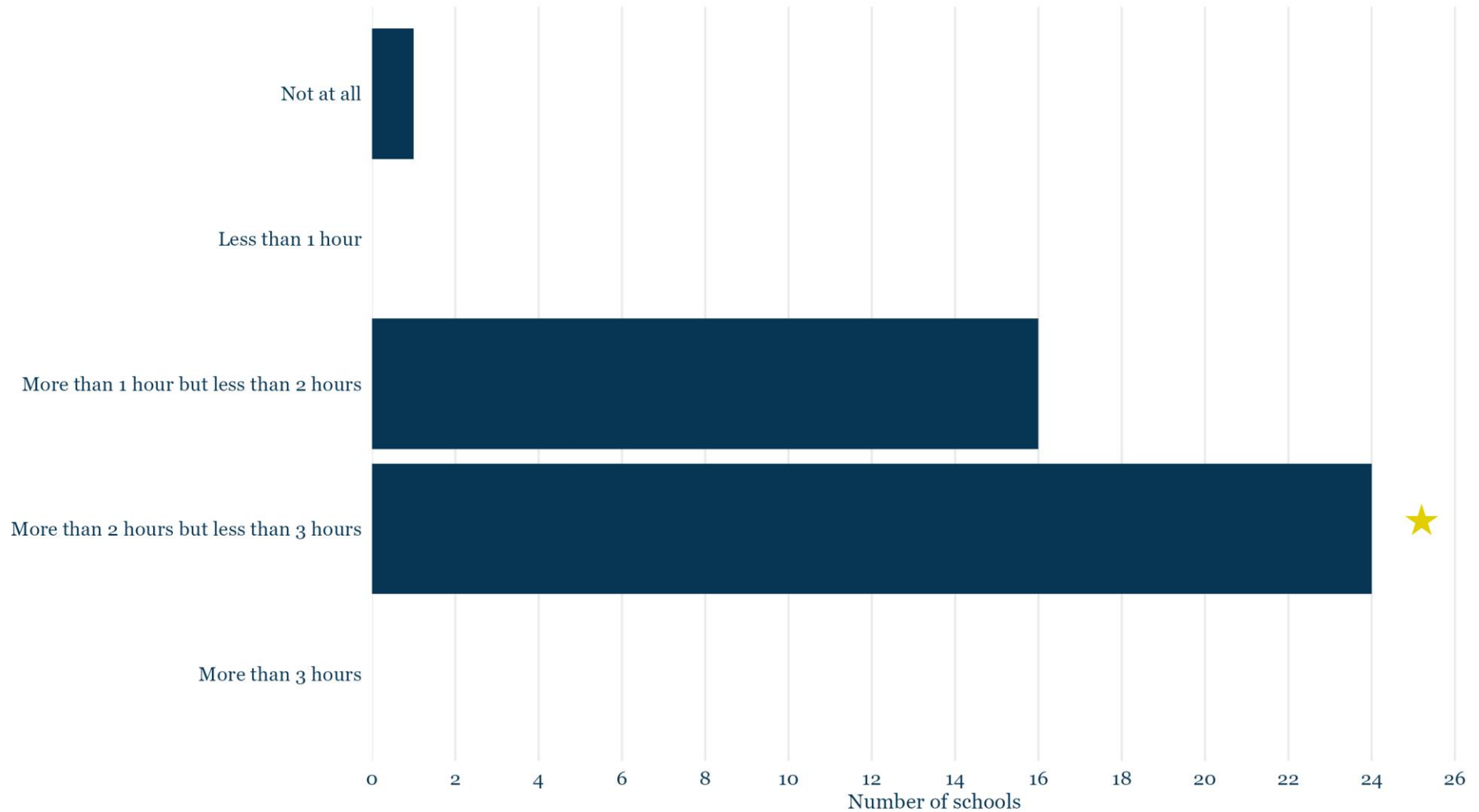


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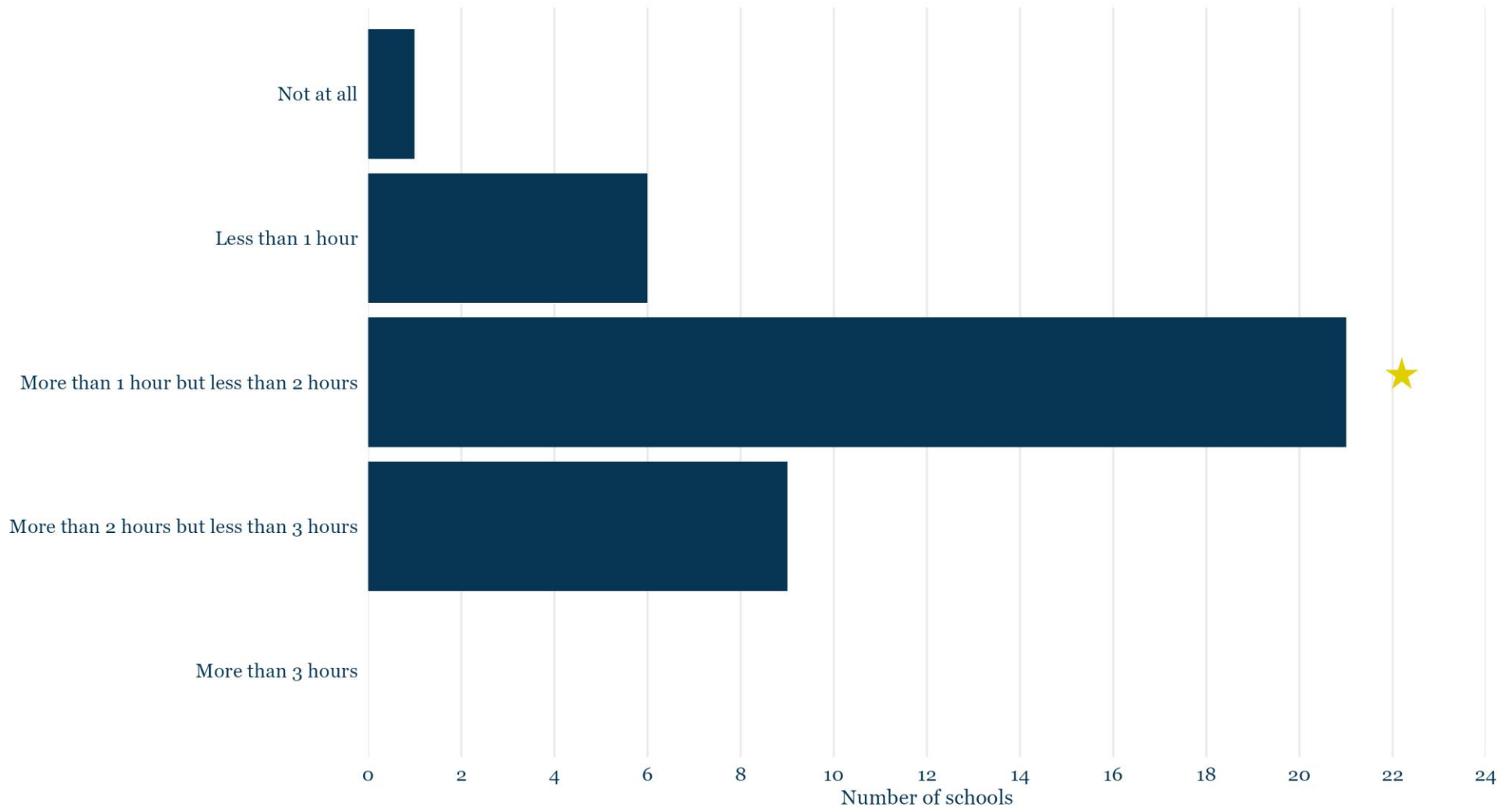
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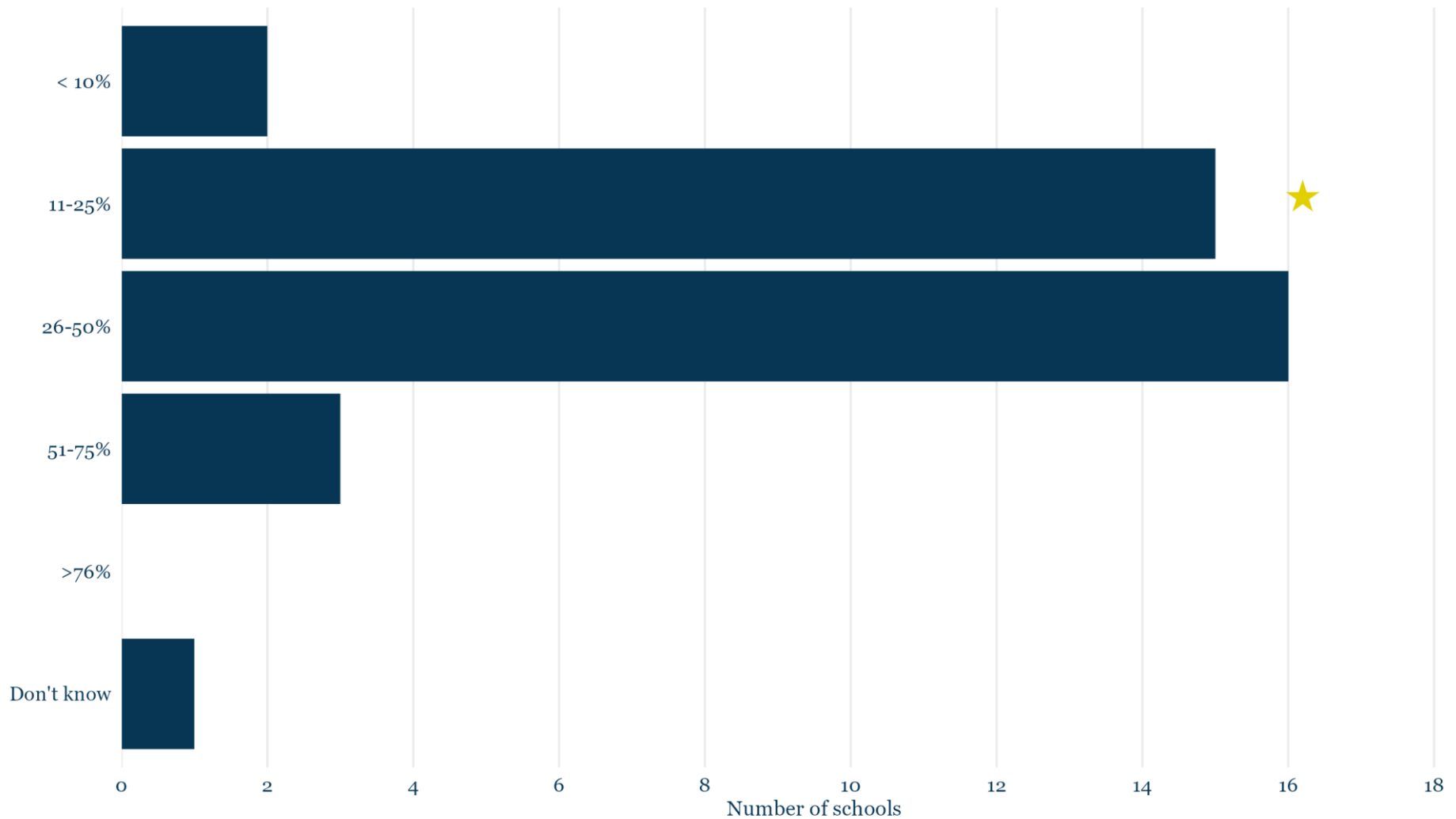
# How long, on average, do pupils engage in universally mandated physical education per week in KS3? Your school as compared to participating schools across the region.



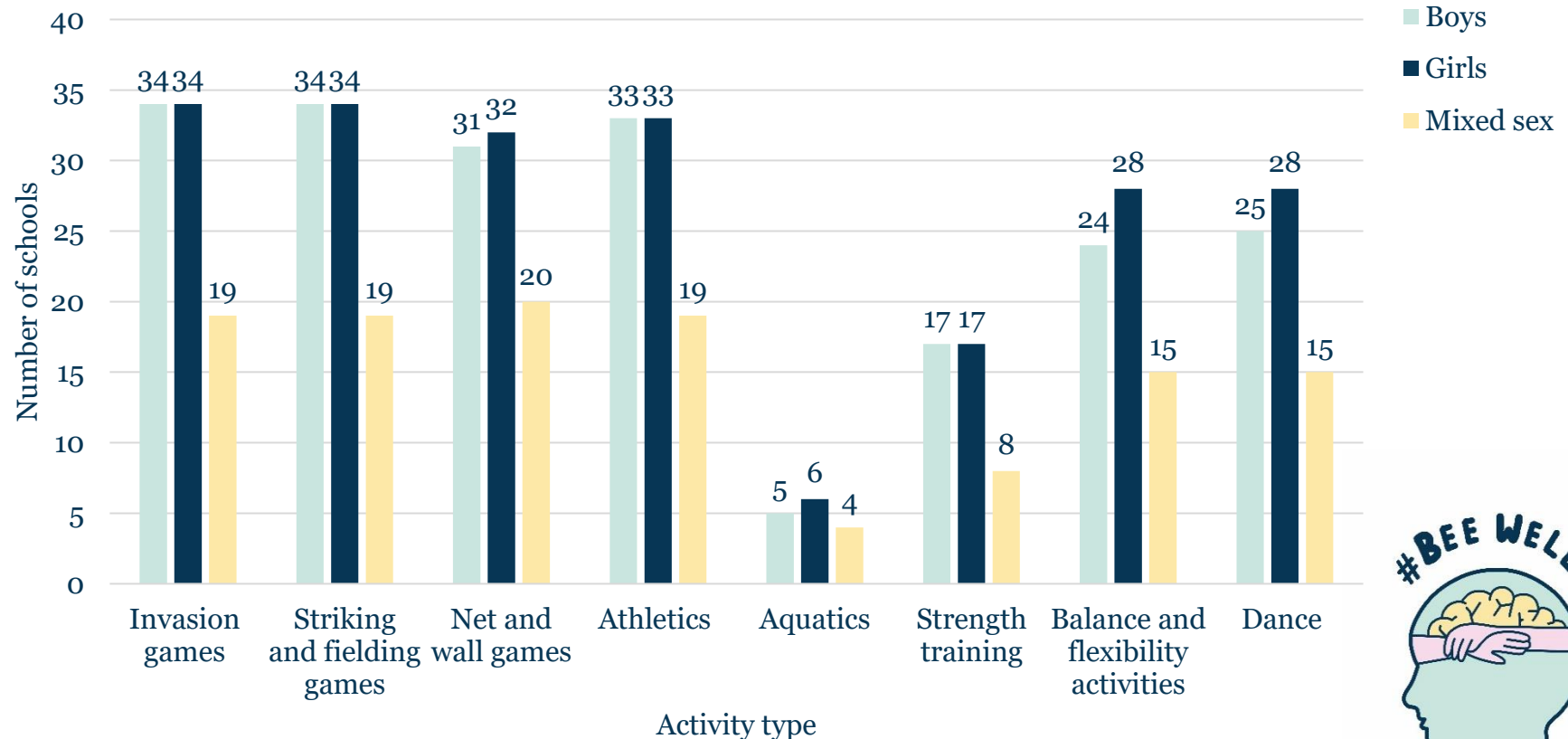
# How long, on average, do pupils engage in universally mandated physical education per week in KS4? Your school as compared to participating schools across the region.



# What proportion of pupils currently registered for KS4 are taking an optional physical education qualification? Your school as compared to participating schools across the region.

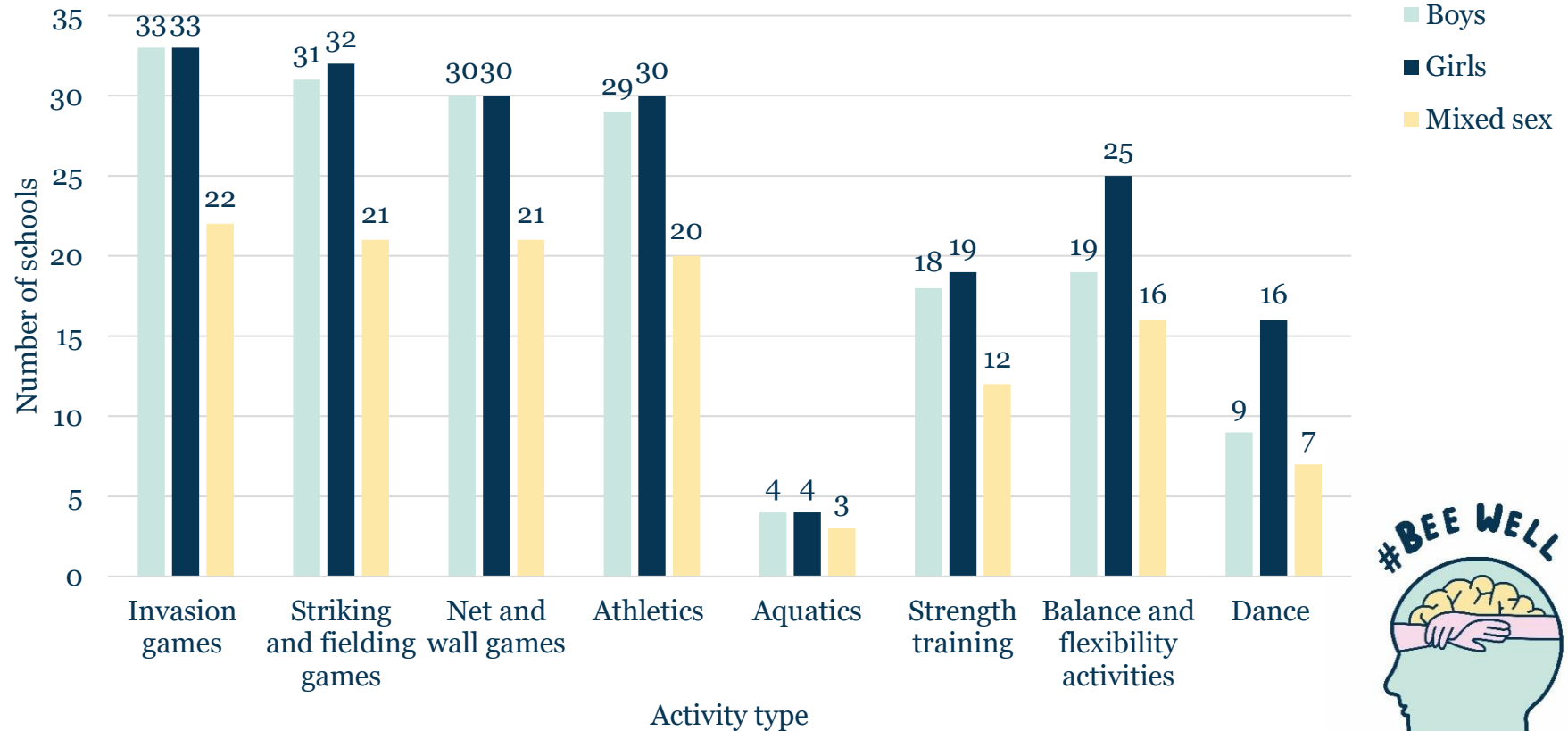


# How many schools in the area have offered the below activities to pupils within the KS3 curriculum within the last two academic years?

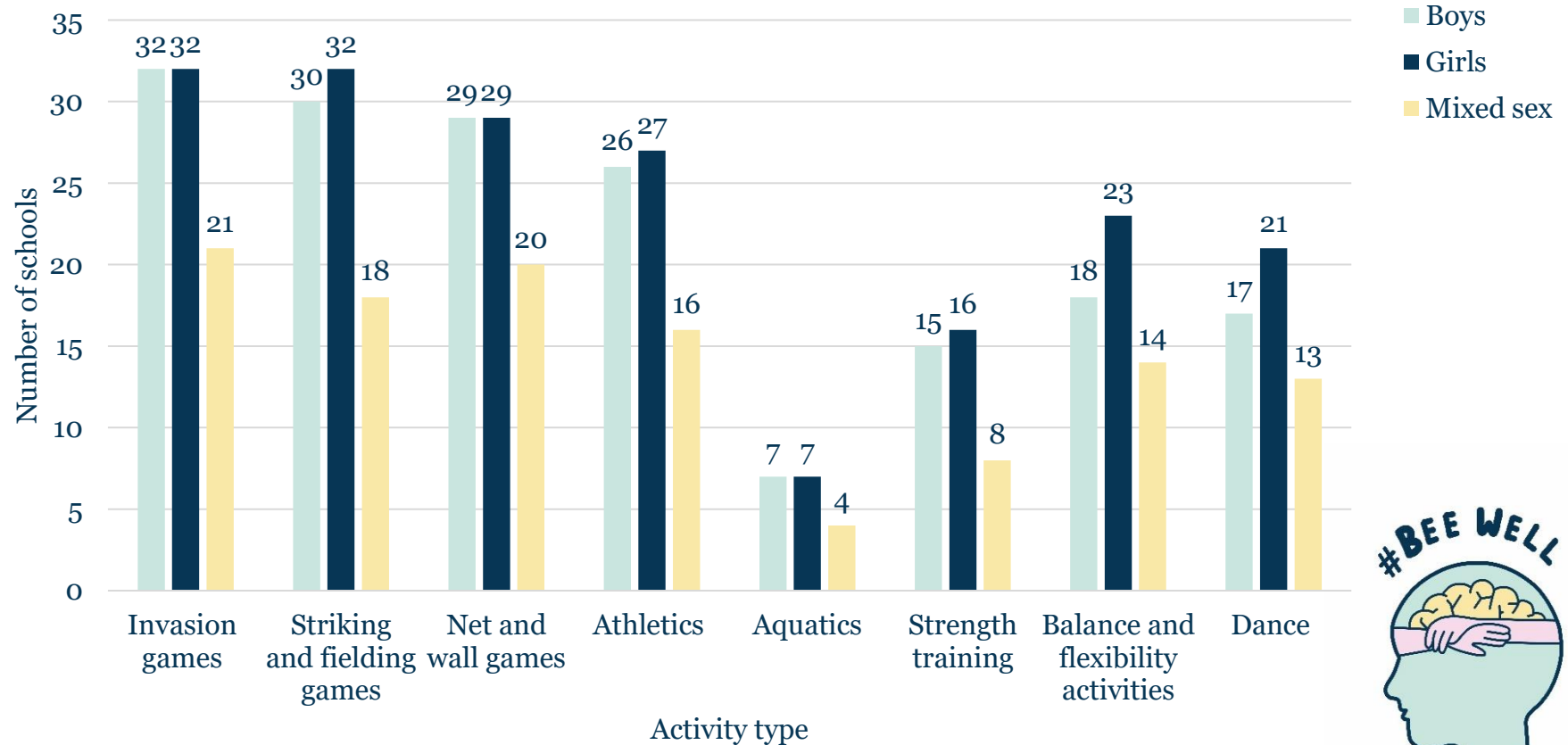




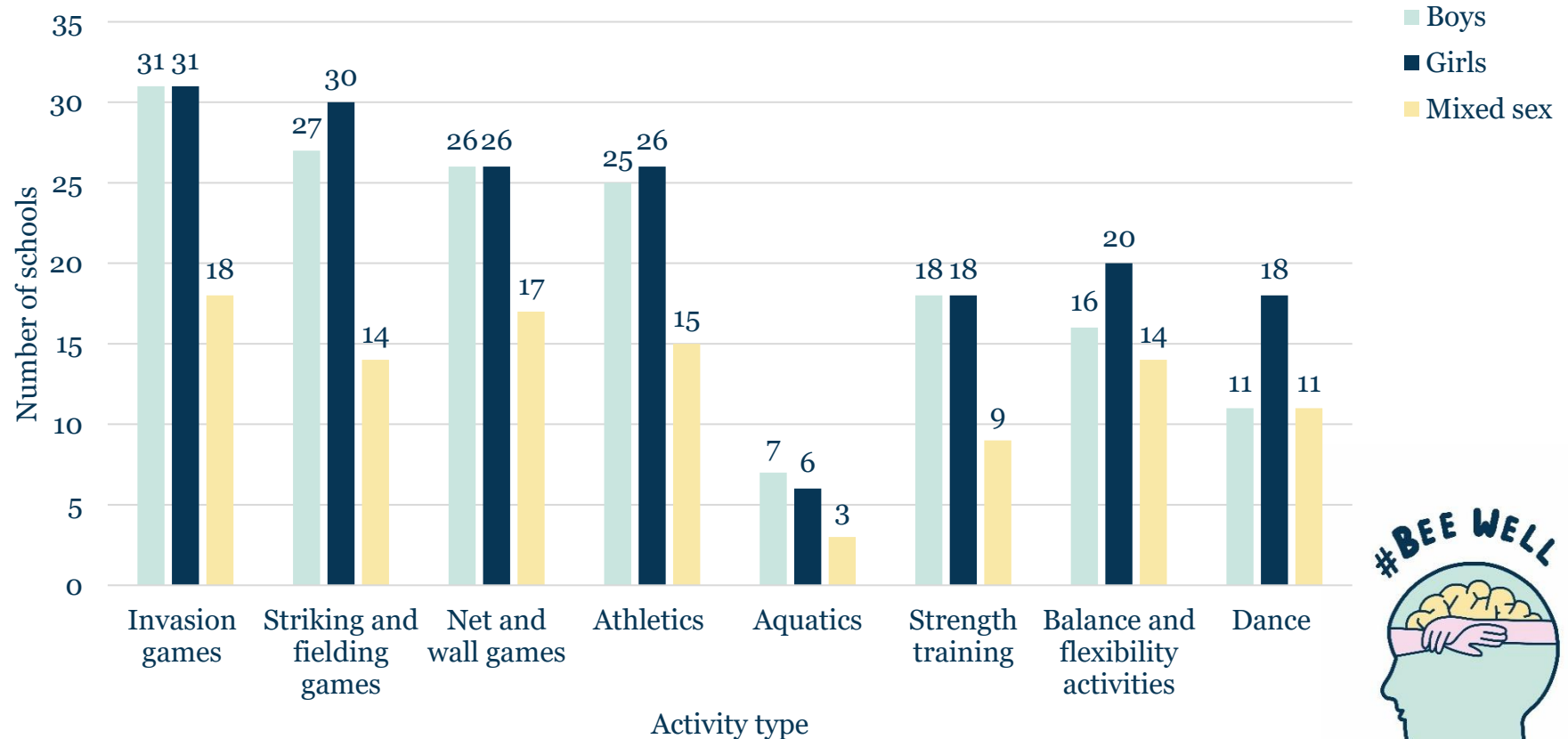
# How many schools in the area have offered the below activities to pupils within the KS4 curriculum within the last two academic years?



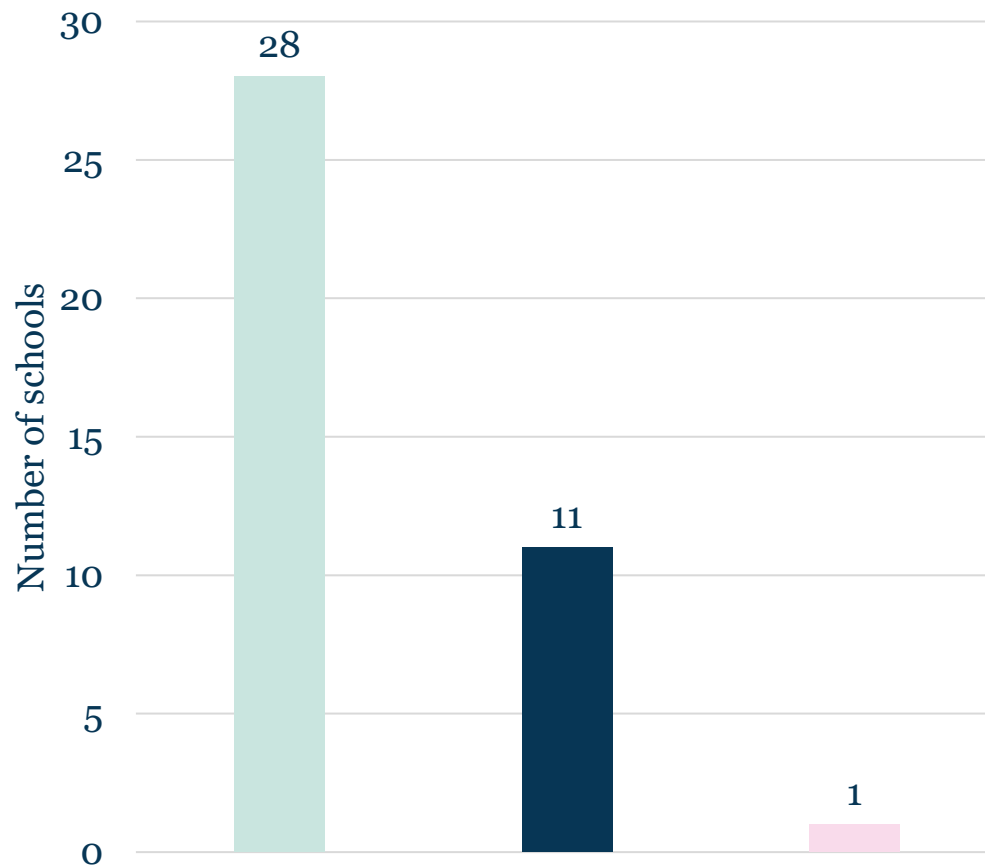
# How many schools in the area have offered the below activities to pupils within KS3 as an extra-curricular activity within the last two academic years?

# Thinking about the extra-curricular activities listed above, how diverse are the group of pupils who attend these activities?



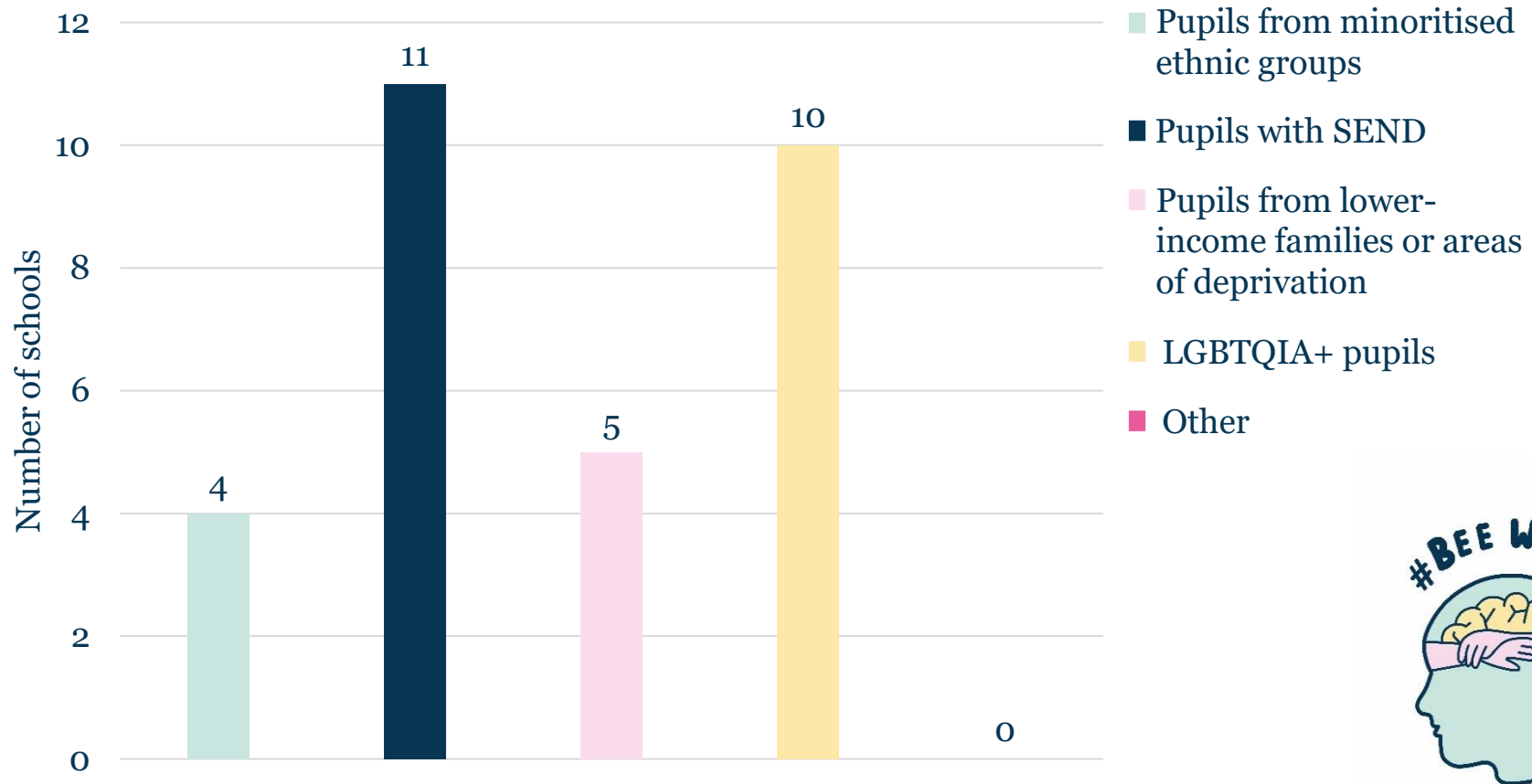

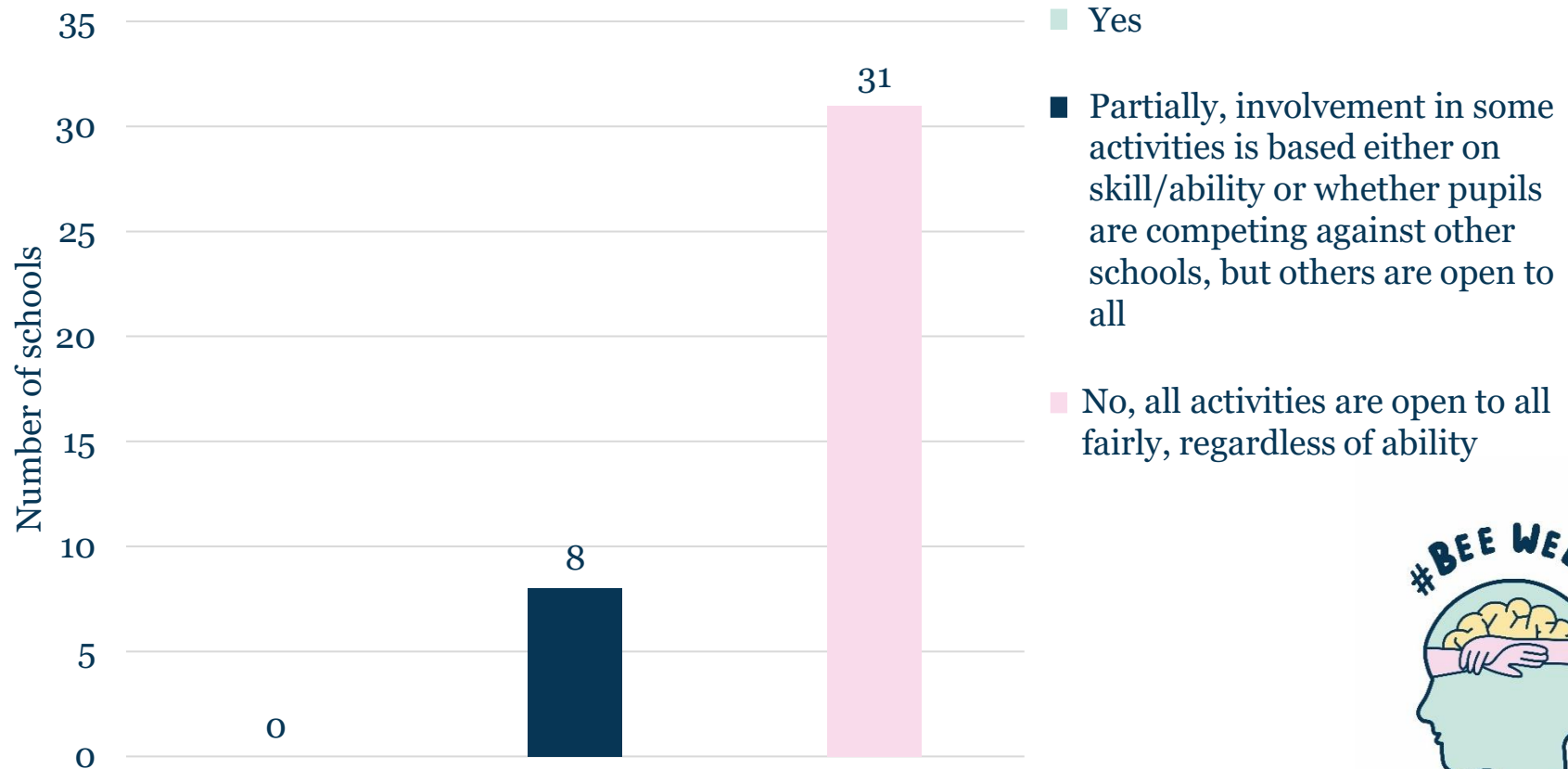

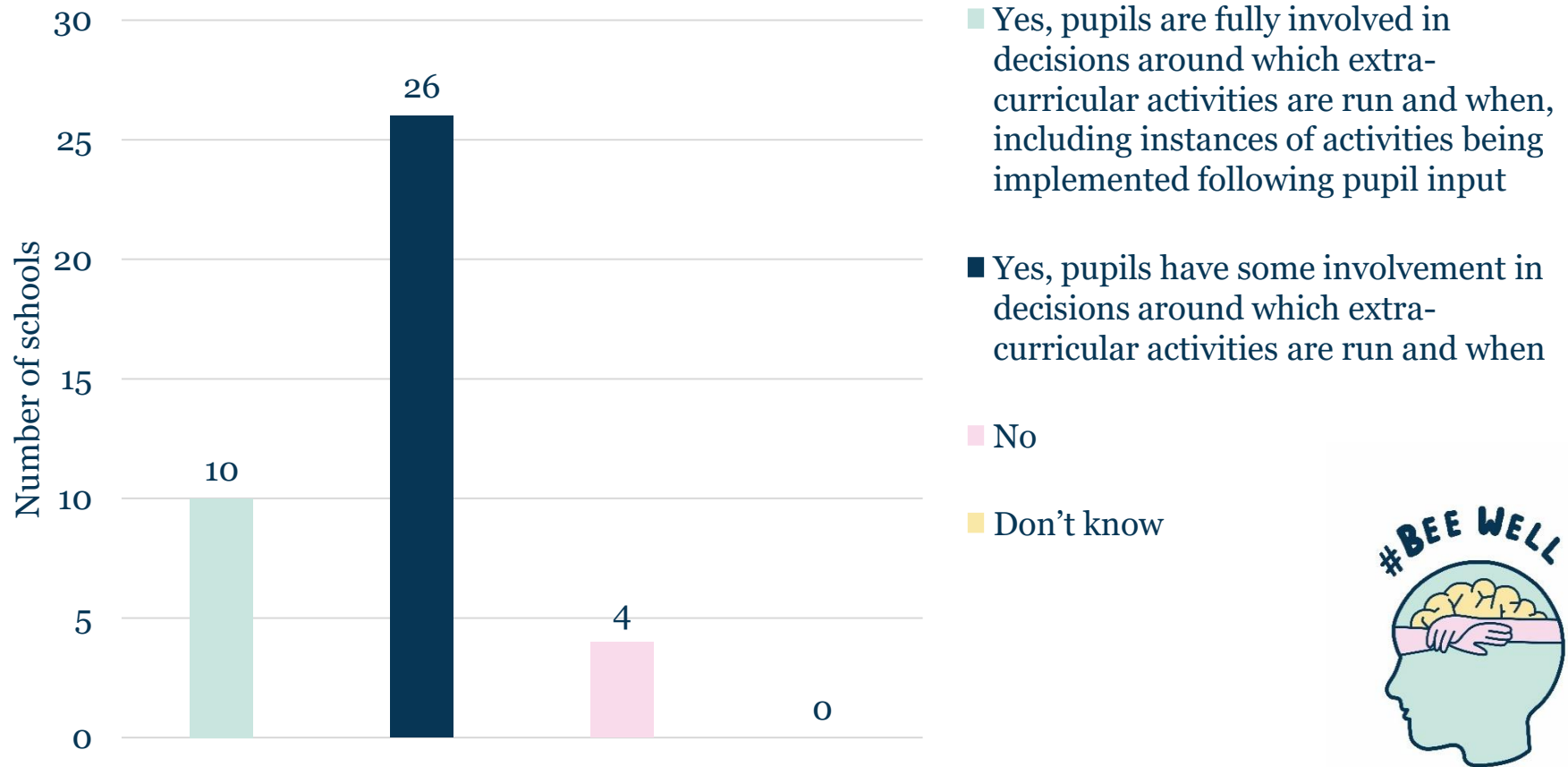

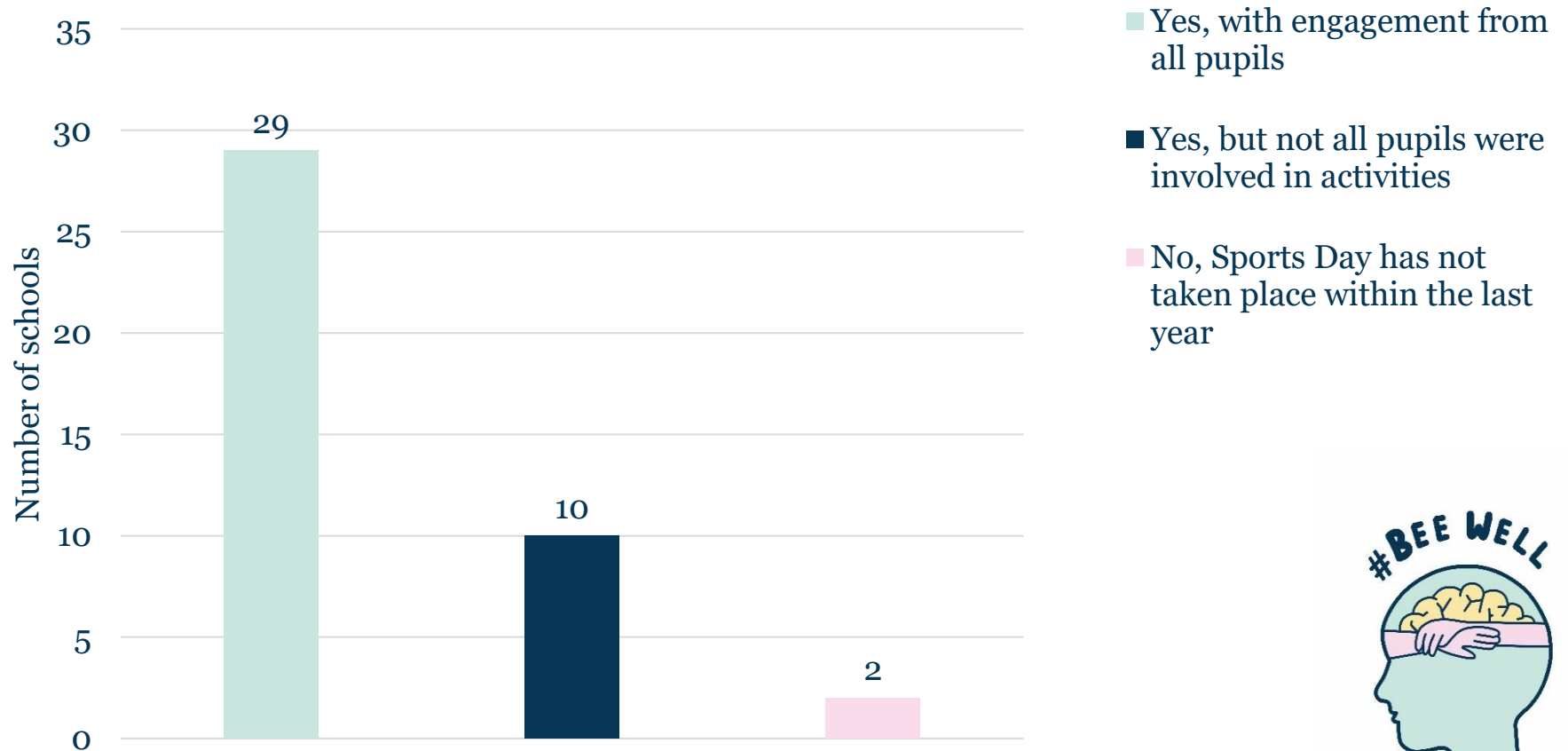
# Are there criteria for participation in extra-curricular activities based on skill or ability?



# Do pupils have any say in which physical activities or sports are offered as part of the curriculum or as extra-curricular activities?

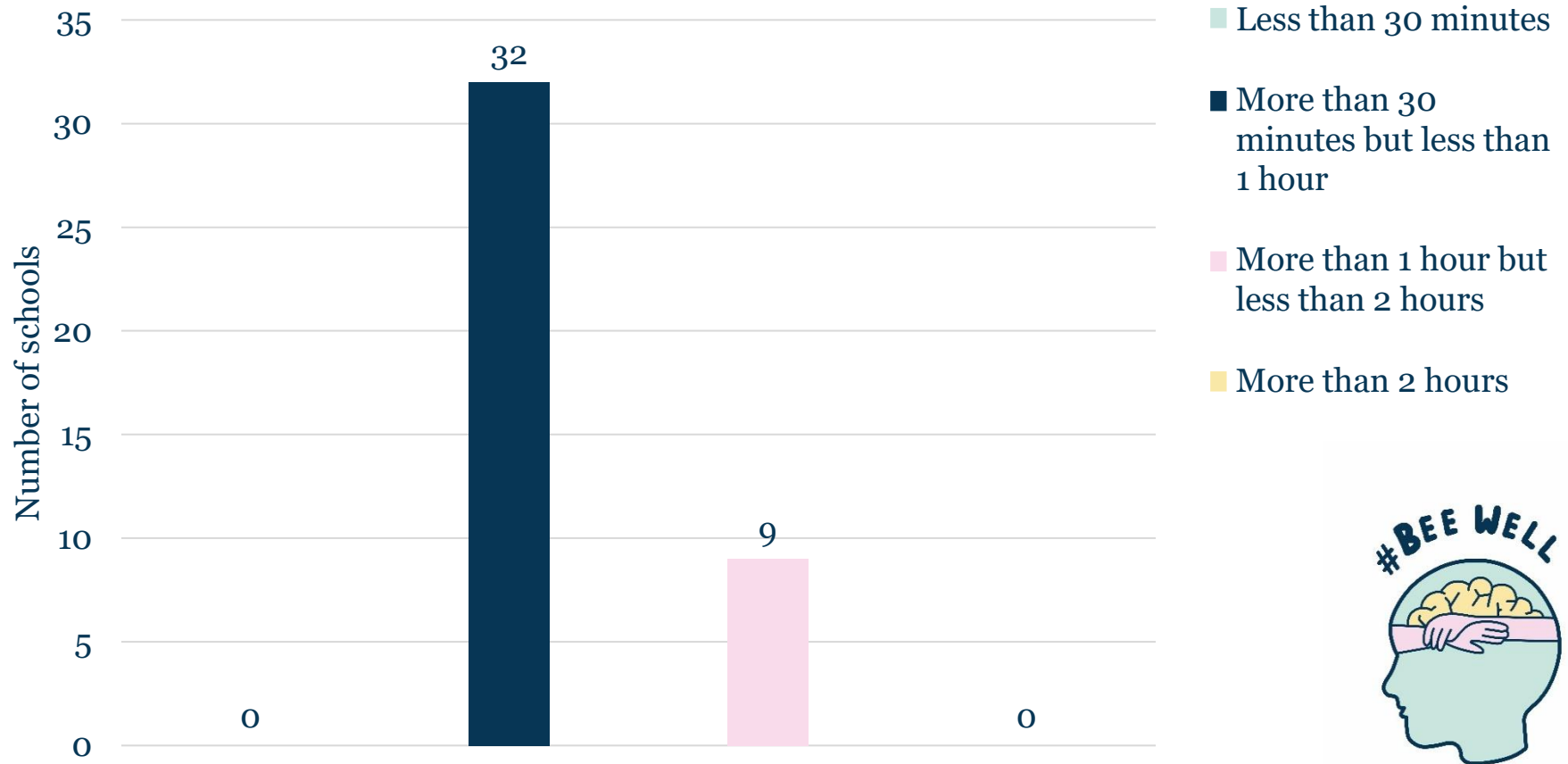


# Has your school had a Sports Day within the last year, where all pupils are encouraged to be involved?

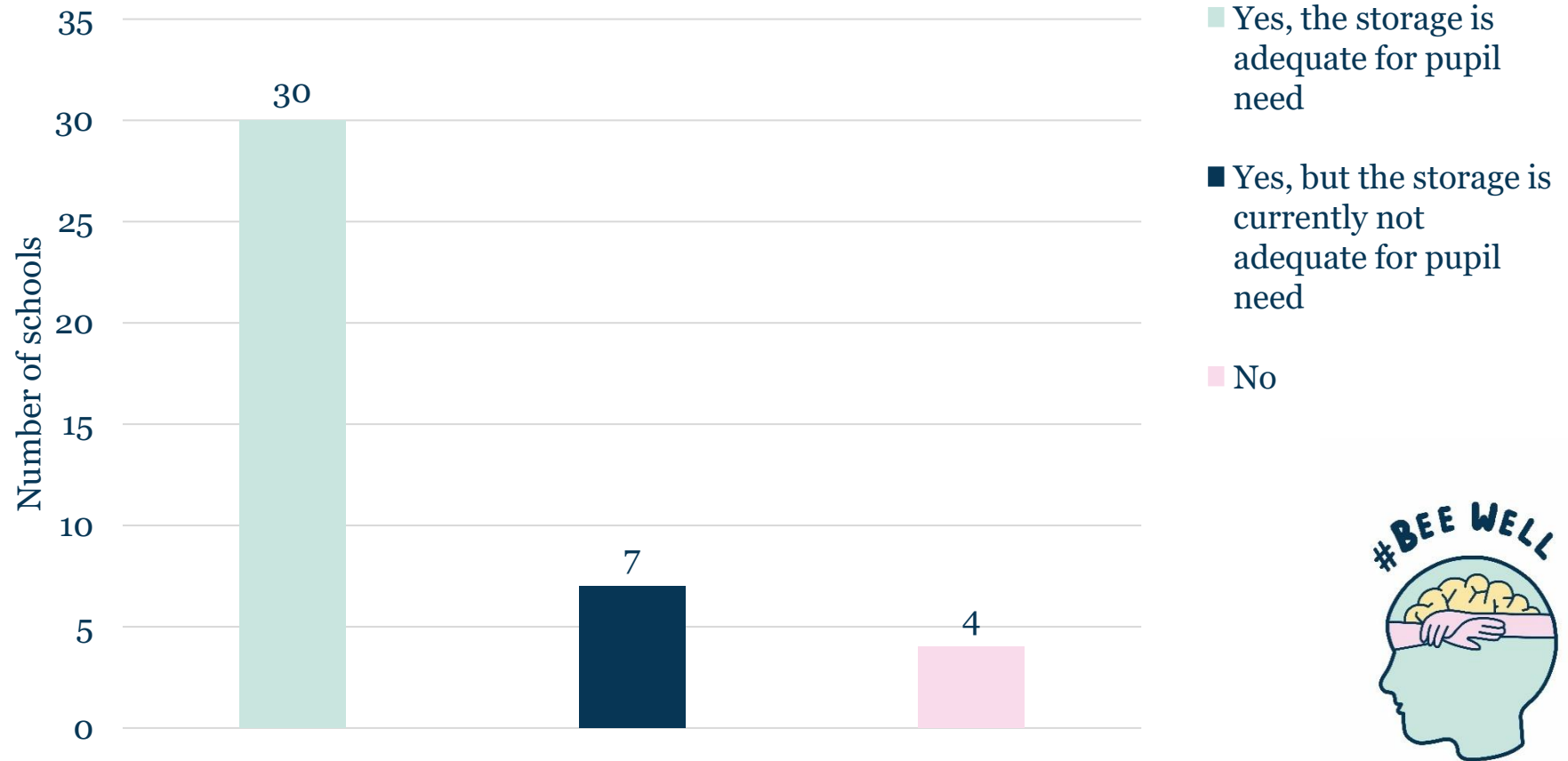




# How much free time (e.g. break and lunch times) do pupils have per day where they can be physically active?
